Andrew Ducharme, 76, of Bangor, passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, February 8, 2024, surrounded by his loving family.

Andrew was born in Pen Argyl, PA, a son of the late Peter L. and Carmella DeMarcantonio Ducharme Sr. He and his beloved wife Gloria (Reed) Ducharme were married 52 years last June 26th.
