Anthony Casciano, 68, of Roseto passed away Wednesday, July 10 at Temple University Hospital surrounded by his loving family.

Anthony was born on February 9, 1956, in Easton, PA, a son of the late Philip A. "Skatie" and JoAnne (Moss) Casciano. He and his beloved wife Toni Ann (Kralik) Casciano were married 38 years on April 11th.

He owned and operated the former Connie Blouse of, Roseto, Holiday Fashions of Slatedale, and ScreenPAC of Roseto.

His great athletic career at Pius X High School where he was a 1974 graduate. He was a member of the Athletic Hall of Fame Class of 1991, three sports Athlete football, Basketball, and Baseball. A Norco Legion member of the Hall of Fame class of 2009, 1974 Norco Legion Champions of Roseto, 1974 Outstanding Athlete Award, Norco All-Star 1972 to 1974. At East Stroudsburg University, he was a PSAC Championship football team member. He was on the Holiday Jacks Men Slow-Pitch Softball team with Multiple State Championships and League championships. He coached at Pius X High School Baseball, Football, and Girls Basketball. As the Head Baseball coach for 21 years from 1993 to 2013 his career record is 276-135-1 with Multiple District XI Championships, Eastern Conference Championships, and Mid-Penn League Championships. At Notre Dame High School of Green Pond, he was the defensive coordinator and assistant coach for ten seasons with multiple District XI Championships, and Colonial-Schuylkill League Championships. He also was Roseto's Northampton County Legion Baseball

Coach.

In addition to his wife Toni Ann, he is survived by his beloved children and grandchildren. A son Frankie, and his wife Julie, and their sons Joseph and Vincent, Daughters; Christina Gilliland and her husband AJ, their children Emma, Cash, and Noah, Elizabeth Casciano and a son Anthony Jr., a sister Constance "Connie" Stambaugh and her husband Michael, a nephew Philip Stambaugh and his wife Courtney and their daughter Brooklyn.
