



## Aurelio Falcone

July 24, 1939 - August 3, 2025

Aurelio Falcone, 86, of Bangor, passed away Sunday, August 3, 2025.

Aurelio was born in Roseto Valfortore, Province of Foggia, Italy, on July 24, 1939, the son of the late Filippantonio and Maria Grazia Sbrocchi Falcone. His beloved wife for 59 years, the former Annette Martocci passed away in 2020.

As a young man, he migrated to Toronto, Canada, with his brothers and sister. He later became a U.S. Citizen, married Annette, and they resided in Roseto, PA. He became a tailor by trade. After an apprenticeship and a few years of practice in the trade, he opened his textile business, Girl Fashions, Inc., specializing in women's garments.
