Doug was a 1969 graduate of Pen Argyl High and Kutztown University in 1973. He was the Art teacher at the White Township Consolidated School, Belvidere, NJ retiring after 35 years. He received the 1991 Teacher of the Year award and had coached several Boys and girls sports teams. He was a local artist who painted many scenes of our beautiful area. For as much as Doug loved to paint, his real passion was sharing his love of art with many students over the years. Doug is beyond talented, not just due to his impressive artistic ability, but also in his ability to teach and inspire others. He is a grounded man with a deep appreciation and passion for ensuring that what was seen, and what is seen, will live on and be preserved through his art. He was a member of First United Methodist Church, Bangor and the Slate Belt Quoit League.
