Ferdinand L. “Chubby” DeBerardinis, 90, of Roseto, passed away suddenly on Monday, October 14, 2024 at home.

He was the son of the late Attilio and Rose (Anacola) DeBerardinis. He and his beloved wife, former Theresa DeFranco, were married 66 years last May. He was a 1953 graduate of Easton High School class of 1953. He honorable served in the US Marine Corps for three years during the Korean War. He owned and operated Chubb's Garage in Roseto for 60 years. Chubby had many, many interests including snowmobiling, big game hunting, gardening, building, and repurposing almost anything. His talents were recognized by his grandson Joey, who wrote his college entrance essay on his grandfather and all that he had learned from him. All who knew him would acknowledge his generosity of spirit, willingness to help others, and his religious devotion. He provided the celebration float for the Mt. Carmel Big Time celebration since 1968.

He was a member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church, Roseto. In addition to his wife Theresa, he is survived by a son John, and his wife Laura of Bangor, and two grandsons; Joseph and his wife Bridgett of Gilbertsville and Matthew of Bangor, Two great-granddaughters; Ella Grace and Isabel Rose.
