James Frare, 79, of Nazareth, passed away on Saturday, February 1, 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born November 27, 1945, in Pen Argyl, PA, and a 1963 graduate of Bangor Area High School. James was the son of Lawrence and Jennie Frare (DeLorenzo). He joins his father, Lawrence, who earned both a Purple Heart as well as a Bronze Star for bravery at D-Day, his mother, Jennie, who passed in 2006, and his brother, Lawrence, who passed in 2024, as well as aunts Aurora and Alba DeLorenzo, previously of Bangor, and uncles.

James attended East Stroudsburg University and worked at Lafayette Bank for many years culminating as Assistant Vice President. He was employed for over 30 years at the Easton Post Office as a postal clerk. James lived his life caring for others with his wife, Marylouise. He belonged to the Holy Family Bowling Club and was an avid fan of the New York Yankees. He loved traveling, watching sports, and spending time with his family, especially his granddaughters.
