



## Jeffrey David Docking

October 19, 1976 - June 17, 2025

Jeffrey Docking, age 48, passed away on June 17, 2025. Jeff was born in Easton Hospital on October 19, 1976, the son of David and Nancy (Guida) Docking of Bangor, PA. He was raised in Bangor and graduated from Bangor Area High School in 1994. Following graduation, Jeff attended Boston University, where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Advertising with a Minor in Sociology in May 1998. Jeff enjoyed living in the city of Boston so much during his time at college that he remained there until the time of his passing.

Jeff was a hardworking and dedicated employee with over 25 years of experience in marketing across various companies and positions. His longest tenure (14 years) was spent at Staples, Inc. in Framingham, MA, where he held several roles of increasing responsibility before becoming a Manager, Account Management and Brand Strategy. In addition, Jeff spent 7 years as Marketing Director at MERGE in Boston, MA, where he planned and executed digital and integrated marketing campaigns for clients across the healthcare, insurance, and financial services industries. Jeff also held positions at Commonwealth Care Alliance and Havas Edge, both in Boston, as well as at Bernard Hodes Group, Inc. in Cambridge, MA.

Outside of work, Jeff enjoyed traveling, spending time with friends and family, and caring for his dog Daniel, who he rescued from an animal shelter 9 years ago. He also served as President of the Homeowners Association for his building. Jeff is survived by his parents, David and Nancy (Guida) Docking,

sister Andrea Heyler, and nephew Ethan Heyler. He was predeceased by his grandparents Carmen and Mary Guida, and William and Jeanne Docking. A Memorial Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, July 10, at 11:00 AM in Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church, Third and Garibaldi Avenues, Roseto.
