Joseph "Buddy" Bartosh Jr, 81, of Bangor, passed away Sunday, July 6, 2025. Joseph was born in Roth, VA, a son of the late Joseph and Elizabeth (Voreh) Bartosh Sr. He and his beloved wife, the former Annette Greko, celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary last November.

Joseph honorably served in the US Navy during the Vietnam War and held the distinction of being the Plank Holder for the USS Kitty Hawk.
