



## Joseph John Ronca

Joseph John Ronca, 86, of West Bangor, passed away peacefully on April 6, 2025.

Joe was the son of the late Joseph and Rose (Peters) Ronca.

A graduate of Bangor High School, class of 1956, Joe was the owner and president of J & R Blouse Co., located in Roseto, PA. He served honorably as a member of the United States Army National Guard. Joe was a lifelong member of the Roseto Independent Presbyterian Church, where he served as Organist, Elder and Church President. He was an active member of the Bangor Elks.

An avid Lionel train enthusiast and collector, he was a member of the Train Collectors Association and enjoyed traveling with friends to train shows around the state. Joe meticulously maintained his yard and vegetable garden and shared the fruits of his labor with family and friends. He would wake up early for many years to start his day with his Roseto breakfast club.

Known to friends by the nickname Joe Boat, he enjoyed boating and water skiing on Lake Wallenpaupack and sailing with his wife on their Catamaran, the Tequila Sunrise.

Family meant everything to Joe. He married his wife Joan (Peron) Ronca on June 28, 1980, celebrating nearly 45 years of marriage. They were blessed with their son Joseph, his wife Sheena and their son Miles, who, to Joe's great delight, shares his love of trains. Joe was a proud member of the Peron family and spent many happy times with his sisters-in-law, brothers-in-law and their

children. Joe is also survived by his niece, nephews and many cousins and dear friends. Joe was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Michael.
