Kyle DeFranco, 48, of Pen Argyl, PA passed away Wednesday, January 19th at his residence. Kyle was born Nov. 20, 1973 in Easton, PA, the son of Domenick and Jean (Golden) DeFranco. He was a 1991 graduate of Bangor High School, and attended Temple University and Allentown College, earning a degree in computer programming and technology.

In high school he was a member of the school's Scholastic Scrimmage team and was recognized as the top Social Studies student in his senior year. At Temple, Kyle was in charge of the school newspaper's editorial department. Kyle worked as a programmer for various companies, the last 6 years with Tracy Becker, Inc. in Macungie. He absolutely loved his employment there and spoke fondly of his employers and co-workers.
