Lawrence Rosato of Bangor passed away peacefully surrounded by family on April 15, 2022. He had just celebrated his 63rd birthday on April 6th. Lawrence is predeceased by his loving parents, Lorenzo and Anna (Spagnola) Rosato. He is survived by his siblings, Nicholas Rosato and his wife Jane Hill-Rosato of Bangor and Mario Rosato and wife Marybeth of Gainesville, Virginia in addition to 2 nieces, Brittany and Meridyth Rosato and 3 nephews, Domenick, Salvator, and Jonathon Rosato and two great nephews.

Lawrence was an amazing person, with a kind and gentle soul who made everyone feel special, leaving them smiling and laughing with his wonderful sense of humor.
