Paul Chester Ennico, 75, of Bangor, PA, peacefully passed away Saturday, August 2, 2025 in St. Luke's Hospital in Fountain Hill. He was the loving husband of Jane (Whitehead) Ennico for over 33 years.

Born in Fountain Hill, June 12, 1950, he was the son of the late Chester and Julia (Sabatino) Ennico. He was a 1968 graduate of Bangor High School and a 1972 graduate of East Stroudsburg University.

He was a teacher at Taylor Street Elementary School, owner of The Last Detail, and salesman at several auto dealerships. Post "retirement" he was a substitute teacher at Bangor High School, a courier at St. Luke's Health Network, and the proud owner of Chill On Wheels 2. He was affectionately known as "The Ice Cream Man" throughout the Slate Belt and supported many community events over the past eight years.

He was a member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church, Roseto, and the Bangor Elks 1106. He adored his family and loved spending time with them. He was a golfer, car enthusiast, and Washington Commanders fan.

In addition to his wife, he will lovingly be remembered by sons, Marc P. and his wife, Christine; Michael A. and his companion, Jamie Frey, both of Bangor; a daughter, Samantha J. and her fiancé, Owen Daddona of Coopersburg; two grandchildren, Carter and Haven; a brother, Louis and his wife, Roxanne; and many cousins, nephews, and niece.
