Philomena A. Gruppo, 78, of Allentown passed away Saturday, May 24, 2025, in St. Luke's Hospital- Allentown Campus, Allentown, PA.

Philomena was born in Easton on January 3, 1947, the daughter of the late Leonard and Concetta (Castano) Gruppo.

Philomena was a 1965 graduate of Pius X High School and furthered her education at Villanova University, where she earned a degree in nursing in 1969. She attended Boston University, where she received a Master's Degree in Nursing in 1975. She then received her Nurse Practitioner Certificate from Northeastern University in Boston, MA, in 1980. Additionally, she received a Master's Degree from the University of Pennsylvania in Government Administration in 1991. Using her education she worked at the Children's Hospital in Massachusetts, taught Nursing at Boston College, Sacred Heart Hospital School of Nursing, and East Stroudsburg University, and was a nurse practitioner at Fernald State School for people with Developmental Disabilities in Mass, and also had a consulting practice for people with severe Disabilities and finally was Director of Nursing at the former Hagedorn Psychiatric Hospital in Glen Gardner, NJ. She enjoyed Cartooning, crocheting, and crafts. She was of the Catholic Faith.

Philomena is survived by a brother Leonard Q. and his wife Lucille (Torcivia) Gruppo of Bangor, and nephews; Leonard Jr. Christopher, and Salvatore, and niece Danielle, great nephew Leonard, and a great-nieces Riley and Sophia.
