Ronold J. Karasek, Jr. of Bangor, PA passed away unexpectedly on Monday, October 21, 2024 at the age of 46.

Ron was born on January 28, 1978 to Ronold J. Karasek, Sr. and Denise Snell (nee Conger).

Growing up, Ron attended Catholic school and graduated from Pius X High School in 1996 where he played football and wrestled. He also graduated from HVAC Technical School. Ron's true passion was in sharing his fire-fighting skills, knowledge and assuring the firehouse was always ready not only for the next call but to also assist others in their time of need.

Ron his enjoyed his yearly salmon fishing trips with his buddies. He loved watching his children play sports, especially his son, Cooper, on the football field. He was beyond proud of his daughter, Addison, with her academic success.
